Description "To raise awareness about wild vegetables and promote their purchase and sale, Vidnyan Mahavidyalaya, Malkapur, through the National Service Scheme (NSS), organized the Wild Vegetable Festival on September 2, 2023. Why these vegetables are called wild vegetables? In fact, all vegetables are grown in fields, and a field is also referred to as 'ran' (wild), so why are only these vegetables called wild vegetables? The answer lies in the fact that these are neglected vegetables, but they are extremely important for human health. In other words, these are vegetables that grow naturally without being planted, and hence they are called wild vegetables.

In the past, our grandparents included these wild vegetables in their meals to a great extent, which contributed to their long lives. Since these vegetables were a regular part of meals, they were familiar to all family members.

Times have changed, and modern meals often consist of vegetables sprayed with chemical pesticides. This shift means that the new generation might not be familiar with wild vegetables, which is why the Government of Maharashtra has started organizing the Ranbhaji Mahotsav (Wild Vegetable Festival).

World Tribal Day is celebrated on August 9 each year. To mark this occasion, the Wild Vegetable Festival is organized. The festival is celebrated on this day to honor the tribal communities who discovered these wild vegetables. Other vegetables are grown by farmers in their fields, but there is no need to plant wild vegetables as they grow on their own. In today's fast-paced life, it is important to include natural wild vegetables in the diet to stay healthy and boost immunity.
